1. Minutes of last meeting were approved. Proposed by BM. & seconded by GC.

2. Treasurers Report:

 117 members joined for 2018 with approx. £5549 in bank with some expense to come ie. maintain 30% subsidy for next kit order; lock up box/ shed for signs; new web site.

3. Club kit:

Next order to be placed end Aug.

4. Events calendar:

- TTs: successful league, 35 riders typical. Consider a separate cross-club TT league committee.
- 5th Aug TLI race—low on entry numbers so far. Closing date 29th July-decision then on whether enough entries to justify a race. Marshalls needed. DN.

5. Saturday Rides:

- Saturday rides generally working OK but complaint re mid group not waiting needs if too big a spread in abilities. Solutions:
 - *Grouping must be done before moving off riders must arrive on time to allow groupings.
 - * Move consideration to be given to abilities rather than balancing numbers. This may result in smaller groups.
 - * If 4 groups, the 2nd group off will be known as "second faster group", they might not slow to allow dropped riders to rejoin.
 - * The 3rd group off is what is known as the "middle group" where no riders will get dropped.
 - * 1st and social groups unchanged.

A 7.30 am "early bird" group to be trialled. WhatsApp messaging groups to coordinate rides to be personal between participants.

"Ride to the Hills" to replace TTs for next 3 Wednesdays – QoS 6.30pm.

Ladies nights – Generally working ok.
